



Home School Curriculum-Draw and Write the Room

Write the Room is a fun way for children to actively engage with letters, numbers, shapes and even words. In this game you place letters, words, pictures, and shapes around the room and children find them.

Write the Room A-Z: Create a simple **recording sheet** with the letters and a space to write the matching letter. Write each letter, capital and lowercase, of the alphabet on an index card or piece of paper. Place them around you home. The letters should be placed at eye level and be accessible. Your child will need a clipboard (or a piece of cardboard and a paperclip) pencil and the recording sheet.

Challenge: The recording sheet can have spaces for the letters but no model.

Modification: Start with 5-10 letters then add more.

Challenge: Write familiar words or words children love on an index card and place them around your home (dinosaurs, movie characters, vehicles, space etc.)

Write the Room-Your Name: encourage your child to find the letters in their names. Create a simple recording sheet for letters in their name and letters not in their name.

Challenge: find the letters in their last name and family member's names.

Modification: provide a model of your child's name.

Write the Room Numbers: Replace the letter card with numbers and create a corresponding recording sheet.

Write the Room Shapes: draw simple 2d shapes on an index card or small piece of paper and label them.
